# **VINTAGE CONDITIONS**

Winter is very wet; perfect for our water reserves but very quickly the spring is hot, the vegetation is once again early. Many people in our vines, a lot of energy to swing into action with the context we know...

The summer is hot but La Tour de Mons vineyard with a predominantly clay soil on limestone resurgences does not suffer. The vine continues its cycle until the harvest in perfect sanitary condition. For this first year of working on this beautiful estate we are delighted as it responds so well to our demands. The Merlots are particularly expressive this year!
