Technical Sheet :

Property director : Bertrand de Villaines

Soils : sand-clay and gravelly

Average of the vineyard : 40 years

Grapes mix : 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet

Harvest and vinification : gravity vatting, pre-fermentation cold maceration, fermentation at 25/27°C with regular rise. Then, 15 days keeping in vat before running-off.

Elelage : 5 months in barrel followed then by 8 months vat aging.
